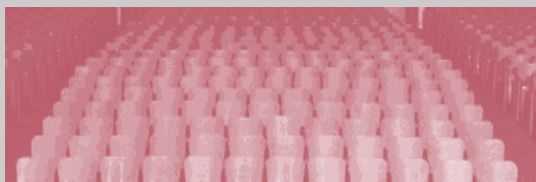


Mercy High School Invites You To Have A Seat!
